Watch some Long Lining demos, hear the explanation, an get to try it with an experienced horse if time allows. Then we'll follow up with a hands on clinic with your own horse in April.

Just what is Long Lining?

- ▣ Long Lining can be described as "riding from the ground". It is a great tool to enhance the training of the horse and rider.
- ▣ It gives the horse the advantage to learn with out having to contend with our weight on their back.
- ▣ It can improve balance and regularity in the gaits.
- ▣ You can observe the way the horse moves. This can shed some light on why they may have some difficulty under saddle in certain gaits or movements.
- ▣ Anything that can be done astride can be done in the long lines, ie - lateral work, ground poles.
- ▣ The rider will master skills involving body language, coordination, connection, balance, timing, and energy projection.

Doreen Garland has over 30 years of experience in the horse industry as a rider/competitor, barn Manager, instructor and a show organizer. Her favorite discipline is dressage but has ridden Hunters, Evented, and has even done some Combined Driving. Doreen's teaching is geared toward building the basics for the horse and rider so they can grow into their discipline of choice. Long lining has become a part of her training and teaching methods. She has been working since 2013 with Richard Malmgren to enhance her Long Lining Skills.

Hunter Show Clinic with Martha Redman

On Sunday October 9th I attended OVCTA's Horse Show Clinic with Martha Redman at Hunter Hill Stables. The clinic was a great opportunity to practice and improve hunter show skills while learning from an experienced professional. It was billed as a "fix-a-test" for hunters and I think that's a perfect description. It was a breezy day in the outdoor up on the hill side for the five horse and rider combinations. The format mimicked a standard hunter division at a show with one under saddle and two over fences rounds. We all flatted together and then took turns jumping. Martha provided feedback after each round and then we immediately re-rode the course.

Even though I'm a card carrying dressage queen, I decided to participate with my 7yo mare Ming because we both enjoy jumping and I wanted to learn more about the details that go into presenting a quality show hunter round from someone who is an active 'A' circuit competitor. My own competitive experiences over fences have been mainly limited to jumpers and combined training where the score is solely based on leaving the rails up. I am thinking of attending more hunter shows this fall so I wanted to gain some clarity about the judging criteria and also get an assessment of Ming's suitability for the sport, in case of a career change down the road.

So here are my three main takeaways about riding at a hunter show:

Create and maintain a consistent rhythm in each gait

Stay quiet with your body so that the judges eye is drawn to the horse, not the rider

Tune the horse to consistently respond to subtle aids

Apply your aids and make any corrections (bending, rebalancing, etc) within the rhythm of the gait

Have a plan for your approach to the first fence and your related distances

The opening circle is where you establish your canter

Adding a stride in rhythm is better than a chip that disrupts the flow of the round

The points above apply to all my fellow hopeful hunters out there. I also picked up some helpful tips that addressed some of my specific challenges coming from riding primarily in dressage tack. I had to be aware of my tendency to default to a full seat position after a jump. This helps my horse rebalance, but it also gets in the way of her "departing the fence" as Martha would say. Which means landing with the forward impulsion needed to get down the line in the ideal striding. The correct idea is to rebalance as needed by smoothly opening your hip angle without compromising your two point position above the saddle. Simple, right?

Another big tip for the dressage-inclined is to keep your vision at the horizon. I have mastered the art of keeping your chin up while dropping your gaze to stare at the horses neck (because we all know that's the best way to tell if they're really on the bit J). But when riding a course, or around the ring with a dozen or more other horses, it's very beneficial to keep both eyes up at all times and have faith that the horse won't suddenly disappear out from under us the moment we stop staring at it. I found that having the right focal point is a powerful aid, especially when approaching a fence off of a turn. It really hit home when Martha challenged me to think about getting centered on a jump coming out of a corner as if I was turning onto centerline in a dressage arena.

I really enjoyed listening to all of Martha's critiques. She is a good communicator and was very encouraging with each rider. It's easy to see how her lessons can cross disciplines and benefit not only hunters, but jumpers, and CT'ers too. I came away with a greater appreciation for a lighter style of riding, and for how athletic top hunter horses have to be. Their canter and jump combine the forward flowing suppleness of a training/first level horse with the engagement and lofty cadence of a third/fourth level horse. My thanks to Michelle P., Hunter Hill Stables, and OVCTA for a great afternoon!
